Group Visits to the Museum

Groups may register for a visit to the museum by calling 508-385-4477, ext. 16. Museum Educator Tours are available Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, beginning at 10 am. Tours are approximately an hour and 15 minutes. Three weeks advance notice is required for Museum Educator Tours; for self-guided tours, call one week in advance. There is a fee for group tours; however, the museum has a grant available for school transportation costs. School groups must include one adult chaperone per 10 students. **Groups must arrive on time;** Museum Educator Tours start promptly.

Students, teachers and chaperones must observe the following:

- Objects or works of art on exhibition must not be touched.
- Only graphite pencils may be used in the galleries. No markers, colored pencils or pens
- Food (including chewing gum) and drinks are not permitted in the galleries.
- **Cell phones must be turned off. No photos may be taken.**
- Coats, umbrellas, backpacks, large bags and lunches must be left on the bus or at the coat rack at the entrance. They may not be carried through the galleries.
- Please have all students wear name tags (first name only).
- Teachers and chaperones are required to supervise students at all times while in the museum.

Special Needs: All galleries and restrooms are wheelchair accessible. All levels of the museum are accessible by elevator. Assistance is available upon request.
