Color and Clay **The Life and Art of Sarah Holl**

August 8 – November 10, 2024
Cape Cod Museum of Art

The list of Sarah Holl's artistic achievements as a ceramicist, painter, teacher and mentor is long. Art has been her life from childhood, growing up in a family of artists and in the family business, Scargo Pottery in Dennis.

In 2022, the Cape Cod Museum of Art publicly recognized Sarah's artistic achievements and commitment to the Cape Cod Art community by honoring her with the CCMoA "Artist Muse Award" and a solo exhibition. The retrospective exhibition, ***Color and Clay: The Life and Art of Sarah Holl*** will be on view this summer and fall, August 8 – November 10, 2024. A Gallery Talk and Reception will be held on Thursday, August 15th, 4:00 pm – 6:30 pm

This retrospective exhibition will present Sarah's wide-ranging paintings and ceramic work that highlights her many artistic accomplishments. From the clay pots (made by her father, Harry Holl) that she decorated when she was 14, to the high relief figurative sculptures, to her glistening large-scale colorful paintings of intimate reflective moments, still lifes, landscapes, horses and pets that she creates in her Dennis Village studio on Route 6a, visitors will be immersed within Sarah Holl's creative world.

Programming related to this exhibition will be offered including a slide presentation by Sarah, a figure drawing workshop and a hand building clay workshop. Dates TBA.

Founded in 1981, the Cape Cod Museum of Art takes pride in Cape Cod's rich art heritage by sharing works from its 2,000 piece Permanent Collection,*and the story of today's vibrant art community through its juried and invitational exhibitions. With a facility boasting seven spacious galleries and an intimate sculpture garden, CCMoA is located at the heart of the Cape in Dennis Village, just off Route 6A and is open year-round, Tuesday through Sunday.
